

Details of the “On-the-spot admission”

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The Teaching Assistantship (TA category) candidates who have applied for admission in the M. Tech programme in the **DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL ENGINEERING** and having a valid GATE score as mentioned below will be eligible for appearing “**On the Spot Admission**” on **Tuesday, 28th July 2026**, against vacant seats.

I. The candidates' eligibility for "the Spot Admission" is as follows:

1. Candidates should have:

- (a) Applied for M. Tech. Programme in the Department of Civil Engineering at IIT Bombay and should be in the WAITING LIST for the academic year 2026-27 (**applicable for CE-3, CE-5, CE-6, and CE-7 where interviews have been conducted**). The list is available in **Table 3**.

- (b) Applied for M. Tech. Programme in the Department of Civil Engineering at IIT Bombay through the COAP portal for the academic year 2026-27 (**applicable for CE-1, CE-2, CE-4 "Direct admission"**) with a valid GATE score above the cut-off mentioned in the **Table 1**.
- (c) SC/ST candidate direct admission on the basis of valid GATE score.

2. Candidates should NOT have "accepted" his/her offer in COAP. However, candidates/students who have already confirmed the admission/ joined IIT Bombay may appear for 'on the spot admission' for "change of specialization" within the department. Moreover, candidates who have accepted the offers at IIT Bombay are not eligible for inter-department movement/shift.

Applicants who have accepted admissions at IIT Bombay for other departments or applicants who have marked "Accept & Freeze" on the COAP portal to accept the offer made by other Institutes, are NOT eligible for "Spot Admission".

Note: The candidates should give an "Undertaking" that they have not accepted the offers on COAP in the format specified.

II. The procedure to be followed is as follows:

1. **Report at Seminar Hall, First Floor, Department of Civil Engineering IIT Bombay by 02:30 pm on Tuesday, 28th July 2026.** No candidate will be allowed beyond this time. Based on specialization-wise seat availability, candidates with higher GATE scores will be given priority for the Spot admissions.

2. **To attend in physical mode ONLY :** The candidates are required to be present in person and no representatives of the candidates will be permitted to participate in the admissions procedure. **No accommodation and travel allowances are given for attending this spot admission.**

3. A consolidated merit list will be put up on the same day (28th July 2026).

4. Selected candidates will receive offer letter on their registered email address, they will have to pay the fees on the IITB admission portal via ONLINE net Banking.

If you have opted for Hostel Accommodation then you are required to submit the Mess Advance of Rs. 27,000/- by ONLINE payment/Net Banking as per the link provided in the online admission portal. The candidate shall directly contact The Deputy Registrar, Hostel Co-ordinating Unit(HCU), Ground Floor, Main Building, IIT Bombay on 022-25768900/8901 or email at arhcu@iitb.ac.in , incharge.hcu@iitb.ac.in /hcu.office@iitb.ac.in , for all hostel related queries. Please note that the Institute provides accommodation on campus strictly for the stipulated duration of Programme under which one is admitted. Hostel accommodation facility is extended to FA/ TA/ RA/ TAP/ RAP/ SW(Monash) category students of all PG programmes. However, please note that due to the extreme paucity of hostel rooms at IIT Bombay the initial two years of accommodation will be in double occupancy.

5. IIT Bombay reserves the right to withdraw the admission at any stage / time in case a candidate does not fulfil the requisite qualifications and/or percentage of marks in qualifying degree or supplies any false information.

Candidates wishing to cancel/withdraw admission after paying the requisite fees MUST communicate the same by an email given in the application form to pgadm@iitb.ac.in and office@civil.iitb.ac.in stating subject "CANCELLATION OF M.Tech. ADMISSION 2026-27(____offer)" by specifying the department/ specialization and application ID. E-mail regarding cancellation/withdrawal of admission will be entertained, ONLY IF, the request is made through E-mail ID given in the Application form.

6c. To process the refund you need to visit the IIT Bombay ONLINE application portal for cancellation request and to enter your own/Self Bank Account No., IFSC Code, Bank and Branch information and upload a proof of this account information.
