Environmental Science and Engineering Department (ESED) will be conducting On-Spot Admissions in this Academic year (2026-27) against vacant seats for M.Tech. programme in TA and RA categories. ESED will be conducting On-Spot admissions in **physical mode only** on **29th July 2026**.

The **Teaching Assistantship (TA category)** and **Research Assistantship (RA category)** candidates who have applied for admission in the M.Tech. programme in the academic unit Environmental Science and Engineering Department (ESED) and having GATE score as mentioned below / as per the enclosed list who are eligible for appearing "On the Spot Admission" on 29th July 2026 against vacant seats.

3. Candidates attending the on-spot selection process for both TA and RA categories will be required to carry their requisite documents including GATE Score Card and undertaking along with them.



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
