Eligibility Criteria for Spot Admissions TA Category:

1. Candidates should have already applied for M.Tech. MMM Programme at IIT Bombay for the academic year 2026-27.
2. The eligibility of the candidates vis-à-vis the submitted declaration (i.e. The candidate has not rejected a previous offer, nor accepted an offer elsewhere, etc.) will be checked. Only those candidates whose declarations are consistent with the available records will be considered for the next step.
3. Candidates should NOT have “accepted” his/her offer in COAP. Candidates who have accepted the offers at IIT Bombay are not eligible for **inter-department movement/shift**.
4. Applicants who have accepted admissions at IIT Bombay or applicants who have marked “Accept & Freeze” on the COAP portal to accept the offer made by other Institutes, are not eligible for “Spot Admission”.
5. The seats offered in each category are subject to the vacancies available in that Specialization/Admission category (A Combination of Birth Category/EWS/PD etc.).
6. Candidates will be considered in the order of their GATE score. A candidate will be shortlisted as per their highest preferred specialisation (as indicated in the application), in which seats are available under their applicable birth/application

category. While the individual group code seat limits will not be considered during shortlisting, the cut-off criteria for the respective GATE papers/qualifying degrees will be strictly applied.

Note:

- The list is operated until the total vacant seats are filled. This is done for each admission category.
- In case there are insufficient eligible applicants in an admission category, the same will be offered to any remaining applicants as per GATE score from other admission category as per their respective cutoffs.
- The spot admission consolidated offer list will be displayed the **same day by 4 pm in the Notice board outside the MEMS department office on 1st floor**
- The decision of the admission committee will be final; no further explanation or reasoning will be entertained.

The procedure to be followed is as follows:

1. Report at Seminar Room (First Floor), Department of Metallurgical Engineering and Materials Science, IIT Bombay, at 9.30 AM on 29 July 2026.
2. The candidates are required to be present in person and no representatives of the candidates will be permitted to participate in the admissions procedure. No accommodation and travel allowances are given for attending this spot admission.
3. Candidates should submit a self-attested copy of the following documents by **11 AM on 29 July 2026** at the venue
 - a. GATE scorecard
 - b. Signed undertaking
 - c. Any additional information form that may be provided to the candidates at the venueNote: All information must be filled clearly in Capital letters only.
4. Candidates who submit their documents by 11:00 AM only will be considered.
5. The candidate may leave the venue immediately after submitting the documents. They should come back to check the results at 4 PM.
6. If needed, the candidate may be contacted by phone by the department.
7. The candidates are requested to wait for the result declaration. In the meantime, they should refrain from contacting the department or the personnel, as it drastically hampers the ability to do the allocation process efficiently.
8. Selected candidates will receive an offer letter at their registered email address. They will have to pay the fees on the IITB admission portal via ONLINE net Banking.
9. The waitlisted candidates will be considered only after the Spot admissions and Fee payments for all the departments are over.
10. The waitlisted candidates will be offered seats only in specializations there are vacancies. There will be no cascading change in the seat allocation to the students who have already been admitted.
11. Selected candidates will receive an offer letter at their registered email address. They will have to pay the fees on the IITB admission portal via ONLINE net Banking.

Please note that the Institute provides accommodation on campus strictly for the stipulated duration of Programme under which one is admitted. Hostel accommodation facility is extended to FA/ TA/ RA/ TAP/ RAP/ SW(Monash) category students of all PG programmes. However, please note that due to the extreme paucity of hostel rooms at IIT Bombay the initial two years of accommodation will be in double occupancy.

ADMISSION 2026-27(offer)” by specifying the department/ specialization and application ID. E-mail regarding cancellation/withdrawal of admission will be entertained, ONLY IF, the request is made through E-mail ID given in the Application form.
