You have been **PROVISIONALLY** selected for admission to **B.Tech./ Dual Degree (B.Tech.+M.Tech.)/ B.S. Programme (as applicable)** at this Institute.

You will be governed by the Institute's rules and regulations throughout your stay at IIT Bombay. You are expected to maintain good conduct, adequate academic standing and discipline. You will be allotted a roll number which will be your unique identification number.

Please note that the Institute has discontinued the provision for change of branch.

Reporting and Orientation:

On campus hostel rooms will be available from 20th July 2026 (Monday) onwards. The Orientation and Registration (O&R) programme is scheduled from 21st July 2026 (Tuesday) – 25th July 2026 (Saturday). You are required to report at the Institute by 21st July 2026 (Tuesday), 9:00 a.m. positively and attend the orientation programme, which is compulsory. The instructions/ classes will begin on 27th July, 2026 (Monday). The detailed O&R programme would be displayed on the Academic homepage (<https://acad.iitb.ac.in/information-ug-new-entrants-2026-27>) of the Institute website, tentatively by 20th July 2026 (Monday).

In case, a candidate fails to report on 21st July 2026 (Tuesday), it will be presumed that the candidate is not interested in admission at IIT Bombay and the offer of admission to the B.Tech./ Dual Degree (B.Tech.+M.Tech.)/ B.S. Programme (as applicable) is liable to be cancelled. In case, there is a change in the schedule, the same would be communicated in due course of time. Detailed onboarding process will be available on the Academic homepage (<https://acad.iitb.ac.in/information-ug-new-entrants-2026-27>) of the Institute website, tentatively between 18th to 20th July 2026 (Monday).

Semester Registration:

The academic programme at IIT Bombay runs in a semesterly mode. The duration of the Autumn Semester is from July to December and the Spring semester runs from January to May. Students are expected to register in all the semesters. The registration for the first semester will be done during the orientation week. The schedule for the same will be available on the Academic homepage (<https://acad.iitb.ac.in/information-ug-new-entrants-2026-27>) of the Institute website, tentatively by 20th July 2026 (Monday).

Documents Verification:

You are required to carry original & self-attested copies of the following documents which you have uploaded at the time of JEE (Advanced) 2025 registration process. The document verification schedule would be communicated on the Academic homepage (<https://acad.iitb.ac.in/information-ug-new-entrants-2026-27>) of the Institute website, tentatively by 20th July 2026 (Monday).

1. Class X Mark Sheet/ Certificate or Birth Certificate (for Date of Birth);
2. Class XII Mark Sheet (Qualifying Examination);
3. Certificate of category (SC/ ST/ OBC-NCL/ GEN-EWS), if applicable [in the format provided in the Information Brochure of JEE (Advanced) 2025 or as per Government of India format, issued by the Competent Authority];
4. In case of OBC-NCL/ GEN-EWS category, the certificate must be issued on or after **1st April 2025** or as mentioned in JoSAA 2025 Business Rules;
5. Original Certificate for Persons with Disabilities (PwD), if applicable [in the format provided in the Information Brochure of JEE (Advanced) 2025, issued by the Competent Authority];
6. Original Certificate for persons having less than 40% disability and having difficulty in writing, if applicable [in the format provided in the Information Brochure of JEE (Advanced) 2025, issued by the Competent Authority];

7. Medical Certificate [in the format provided in the Information Brochure of JEE (Advanced) 2025, issued by the Competent Authority] (in specified format available on JoSAA 2025 format, **Annexure 7**);
8. OCI certificate/ PIO card, if applicable;
9. Passport / Citizenship certificate, if applicable;
10. DS Certificate, if applicable (in specified format available on JoSAA 2025).
11. Parental Income Certificate, if applicable (for scholarship) issued on or after **1st April 2026** by the Competent Authority.

Fee Refund Policy for UG New Entrants:

1. Deduction of Seat Acceptance Fees and Processing Charges: Whenever a student who secures admission to IIT Bombay chooses to withdraw before the last date of payment of Semester Fees, the student will receive a refund of the Semester Fee after deducting the Seat Acceptance Fees and Processing Charges of Rs. 5,000/-.
2. Refund of Caution Deposits: Whenever a student who secures admission in IIT Bombay chooses to withdraw after the last date of payment of Semester Fees, the student will receive only the refund of Caution Deposits (Institute, Library and Hostel) subject to 'No Dues'. Mess charges will be collected on a pro-rata basis.
