Office Memorandum for Scholarships/ Remission of fees UG & M.Sc. students (2026 Batch)

Applications are invited through online interface for award of the following **Scholarships/ Remission of fees** for the Academic year 2026-27 from the students of following Programmes (Batch):

- B.Tech./ Dual Degree (B.Tech + M.Tech) / B.S. / B.Des. (2026 Batch)- New entrants
- M.Sc. (2026 Batch)- New entrants

Application Portal (my.iitb.ac.in) will be available as mentioned below: Use LDAP login to apply.

Section I) The details of Scholarships/ Remission of fees for academic year 2026-27 are as below

- Institute Merit-cum-Means (MCM) Scholarship** offers Free tuition and annual scholarship (for 10 months) as per eligibility criteria.
- Facilities of Free Messing (only for SC/ ST students)-** Facilities include
 - A monthly pocket allowance (for 10 months),
 - Free Messing (only basic menu), for students who are availing the hostel and mess facilities at IIT Bombay.
 - Exemption from the payment of Hostel Room Rent for students who are availing the hostel and mess facilities at IIT Bombay.
- Women Merit Scholarship of** Rs.10,000/- per year for female Undergraduate students with annual parental gross income (including both parents) of up to Rs. 5 lakhs. This scheme is applicable only with the schemes 1 & 2 mentioned above.
- Remission of fees-** Please refer to eligibility criteria mentioned in Section II.

The details and benefits of Scholarships are mentioned in **Annexure I**.

Section II) Eligibility

1. Merit-cum-Means Scholarship (MCM)

- Parental gross income (both parents combined) for Financial Year 2025-26 must be less than or equal to Rs. 5,00,000 per annum (without any standard deductions).
- CPI criterion is not applicable for 2026 batch students (i.e. new entrants)

2. Facilities of Free Messing, Monthly Pocket Allowance, exemption from payment of hostel room rent (This is applicable for SC/ ST students only).

- Parental gross income (both parents combined) for Financial Year 2025-26 must be less than or equal to Rs. 5,00,000 per annum (without any standard deductions).
- CPI criterion is not applicable.

3. Remission of fees

- Parental gross income (both parents combined) for Financial Year 2025-26 must be less than or equal to Rs. 5,00,000 per annum (without any standard deductions).
- Economically backward UG students admitted in B.Tech./ Dual Degree (B.Tech. + M.Tech.)/ B.S./ B.Des. programme (2026 Batch).
- CPI criterion is not applicable
- Students with a parental income less than Rs.1 lakh per annum are eligible for full remission of the tuition fees.
- Students with a parental income between Rs.1 lakh and Rs. 5 lakh per annum are eligible for remission of 2/3rd of the tuition fees.

Section III) Documents required for scholarship application

Parental Income Certificate (for Financial Year 2025–26):

- Must be issued by a competent authority listed in **Annexure II**.
- Date of issue: **On or after 1st April 2026**.
- Validity: **Up to 31st March 2027**.
- Must be a clear, readable scanned copy.
- Should be digitally verifiable (with QR code/ barcode).
- If not digitally verifiable, original signed certificate must be submitted to the Academic Office for cross-verification before the last date of application.
- All online issued certificates will be verified from respective state verification website. For this purpose, some state verification websites require OTP. Students are required to provide the OTP to the Academic office, UG Unit staff for timely completion of verification.
- It is the responsibility of the student to verify the authenticity all documents before uploading. **Any case of forgery will be handled by the Institute's Disciplinary Action Committee (DAC)**.
- If income certificate is issued to an individual parent, **a statement certifying the gross annual income of both parents is mandatory**. In case there is no income source for one parent, a legal affidavit stating the same is required.

Section IV) Miscellaneous Information

- At the time of verification whose applications are marked for resubmission should upload corrected version in the same round only. There will be no separate resubmission round for students whose applications are not found in order.
- This is a common online portal (**my.iitb.ac.in**) to apply for the scholarship [Named scholarships provided by Dean ACR Office, Institute Merit cum Means (MCM) Scholarships, Facilities of Free Messing (for students from SC/ ST category), Remission of Fees, Women Merit Scholarships (for eligible female Undergraduate students)]
- A student will be awarded the most beneficial scholarship provided the student fulfils the eligibility criteria. The option to select a particular scholarship by a student at the time of application for scholarship is not available.
- Once the application is submitted successfully, a student will receive an e-mail with a copy of submitted application as PDF. Applicants may download the same for future reference.

- The award of scholarship is prospective and not retrospective.
- Application scrutiny will be completed within three working days of submission and the decision of award of scholarship will be conveyed to students by email.
- Fee refund, along with any applicable monthly allowances, for the Autumn semester will be paid within 15 days of approval of the scholarship. Students shall pay the remainder fee as per the scholarship approval for Spring semester. The same will be reflected in the portal.
- If the approved scholarship has pocket money and/or monthly allowance, then the same shall be released by **26 January 2027** for Spring semester after successful completion of registration formalities.

- Applications received between **10th November to 16th November 2026** will not have an option of resubmission. It will either be accepted/ rejected.
- Ensure your bank account details are updated and verified on the ASC portal.
- No request for extension of dates will be considered.
- Students can avail ONLY ONE scholarship at a time. In case you are awarded an external scholarship and/or stipend and you accept the same for the duration in which you are already awarded an Institute Scholarship from IIT Bombay, you must inform the Institute immediately by sending an e-mail to ugscholarships@iitb.ac.in and refund the entire amount of the Institute Scholarship received.
